How we know him: In 2000, Michael Derrig founded Landscape Details, one of the Hamptons' premier landscape design and building firms. Its full-service approach encompasses every aspect of a home's outdoor spaces, from initial design to ongoing maintenance—the company even has its own tree farm. “We do everything from large-scale planning

to small, intimate garden spaces,” he says. “There’s a vast set of skills that we need to be able to pull a whole landscape together.”

Getting started:
